

REPORT ON 15-DAY TREE PLANTATION PROGRAM

“GREEN CITY, INARUWA, SUNSARI”

Program: 15-Day Tree Plantation Campaign

1. Introduction

A **15-day tree plantation campaign** was organized at Green City, Inaruwa with the objective of promoting environmental conservation, increasing green coverage, and contributing to the environmental goals of Rotary District 3292.

As part of the District's environmental initiative, **Rotary District 3292 has set a target of planting 100,000 trees this year at different locations across the country.** In support of this ambitious District-wide goal, the Green City, Inaruwa campaign has set a target of **12,000 trees**, representing approximately **12% of the District Governor's overall target.**

The initiative reflects Rotary's commitment to environmental sustainability and demonstrates how a local community-based project can contribute significantly to a larger District-wide mission.

2. Participation

The program was graced by **Rotary International District 3292 District Governor Rtn. Vishnu Bahadur Karki**, along with Rotarians from the District. **Rotary Club of Patan West President Rtn. Ramesh Adhikari**, members, Rotaractors, **Inner Wheel Club of Patan**

President Inr. Maya Nagarkoti and members, and representatives of **DN Group** also participated actively in the program.

Their presence and active involvement provided encouragement to the campaign and strengthened cooperation among Rotary, Inner Wheel, DN Group, and the local community.

3. Plantation Activities

The plantation campaign is being implemented over a period of **15 days**, with a target of planting **12,000 trees** at identified locations within Green City, Inaruwa, Sunsari.

The campaign is not focused solely on the number of trees planted, but also on ensuring their long-term survival and meaningful contribution to the development of a greener and healthier community.

4. Tree Protection and Sustainability Strategy

To ensure that the initiative creates a lasting environmental impact, a **“Plant, Protect and Preserve”** approach will be adopted. Measures include:

- Providing tree guards and other protective measures where necessary.
- Regular watering, particularly during the initial establishment period.
- Assigning responsibility to local community members and designated stakeholders for care and monitoring.
- Conducting periodic inspections to assess tree survival and growth.
- Replacing dead or damaged saplings where necessary.
- Maintaining basic records of plantation locations and progress.
- Encouraging local ownership and community participation for long-term protection.

Thus, the project aims not merely to achieve a plantation figure but to ensure that the planted trees grow into a **sustainable environmental asset for the community**.

5. Installation of the National Flag

On the same occasion and at the same venue, a **huge national flag of Nepal was installed on a 210-foot-high pillar**, creating a prominent landmark at the site.

The national flag, together with the **Rotary logo prominently displayed at the site**, has enhanced the visibility and public image of Rotary. The initiative provides a strong visual representation of Rotary's presence and commitment to community development, environmental conservation, and national pride.

The combination of the tree plantation campaign and the national flag installation has made the site a meaningful symbol of **environmental responsibility, patriotism, and Rotary's "Service Above Self" spirit**.

6. Outcomes and Impact

The Green City, Inaruwa initiative represents a significant contribution to the District's ambitious **100,000-tree plantation target** for the year. With a target of **12,000 trees**, the project alone accounts for **approximately 12% of the District target**.

The 15-day campaign is expected to increase greenery, improve the local environment, promote community awareness, and encourage greater participation in environmental conservation.

The project has also strengthened fellowship and collaboration among Rotary members, Inner Wheel members, DN Group, and the local community while enhancing Rotary's visibility and positive public image.
